A Necessary Good: Preventing Mass Atrocities in the Trump Era

The United States has long served as a leading voice on preventing and responding to genocide and mass atrocities. Charles Brown, who recently served as Chair of the Experts Committee on Preventing Mass Violence, will discuss the continued relevance and importance of mass atrocity prevention to American national security and explore how the United States could continue to push for effective prevention and response policies.

Charlie Brown currently serves as Managing Director of Strategy for Humanity and as the Leonard and Sophie Davis Genocide Prevention Fellow at the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum. From 2012 to 2014, Charlie served as Senior Advisor on Atrocity Prevention and Response in the Office of the Undersecretary for Policy in the U.S. Department of Defense, where he was responsible for leading implementation of President Obama's initiative to integrate atrocity prevention into U.S. policy. From 2010 to 2012, he served as Senior Director for Rule of Law and International Humanitarian Policy, overseeing Department of Defense policy development and implementation on a range of issues. In the past, Brown has held senior positions at the Institute for International Law and Human Rights, Citizens for Global Solutions, Amnesty International, and Freedom House. During the Clinton Administration, he served as Chief of Staff in the Bureau of Democracy, Human Rights, and Labor in the U.S. Department of State.
